Subject: Synergy of the Medical School Application Process: Streamlining the Secondary and
Interview

Whereas, current policy allows medical schools to individually distribute secondary applications; and

Whereas, medical schools currently schedule interviews independent of any other school; and

Whereas, the current process is inefficient and potentially confusing to both students and admissions officers; and

Whereas, the current secondary application process is environmentally irresponsible; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That AMCAS study the creation of a secondary application paperless portal so that students have a central location to access the entire application process (including, but not limited to the primary and secondary applications, interview information, supplementary submissions and acceptance status); and be it further

RESOLVED, That students will have a central profile so that any information required by medical schools to which the student applies (e.g. demographics, government documents, etc...) will be easily and immediately accessible; and be it further

RESOLVED, That AMCAS will optimally maximize synergistic efficacy.
